These fans were typically handed out at outdoor summer funerals to keep the mourners cool in the oppressive heat.

Instructions:

You will need two pieces of 8 1/2 x 11 cardstock. If your printer can't handle cardstock, print the design (this sheet) on regular paper on your color printer and use a piece of cardstock for the backing. Shirt cardboard works well, although you can also use poster board.

Print one copy of this sheet.

Popsicle or craft stick is glued here.

Cut across the entire sheet on the dotted line.

Glue a popsicle stick or craft stick to the back where indicated. You may want to experiment how long you want it to stick out. Be sure and leave about 2" glued to the fan for stability. Using a thin layer of white glue or spray adhesive over the entire back surface, affix the fan design sheet (with the stick) to the backing cardstock. Once this has dried thoroughly, cut it out on the black line.
